



Appliance/Refrigerant Policy

Dem-Con Metal Recycling will not accept or receive small appliances, motor vehicle air conditioners (MVACs), or MVAC-like appliances with cut or dismantled refrigerant lines, unless it can be verified that the refrigerant was properly recovered in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 82.155(a) prior to dismantling the refrigerant lines using the verification statement below. This statement must identify the person or company who properly recovered the refrigerant and provide the date of recovery.

For small appliances, motor vehicle and motor vehicle-like appliances with intact refrigerant lines, Dem-Con Metal Recycling will recover all refrigerants in compliance with EPA standards.

All units will be inspected before ticket will be paid.
